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GENERAL INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

Individual competition is open to any male or female born from Jan. 1, 1985 to Dec. 31, 1996 inclusively, with the following restrictions:

1. Contestants who are citizens of the United States must be current members of at least one of the following organizations and have current insurance coverage with that organization in force on the day of competition: United States Judo Federation, Inc., United States Judo, Inc., or United States Judo Association.
2. Contestants who are not citizens of the United States must meet the age requirements above, must be current members of their Country's National Judo Federation, and must be able to provide proof of current medical insurance coverage.
3. **No age waivers will be considered or accepted.**

Team competition is limited to eligible USJF Yudanshakai members who meet the eligibility requirements above and the additional requirements on the Official Team Entry Form.

Kata competition is open to any combination of male, female or mixed pairs who meet the eligibility requirements above. Teams may have U.S. and international members.

ENTRIES AND DEADLINES

Official entry forms and waivers, correctly and fully completed along with proof of age, appropriate membership and insurance (see Eligibility), and appropriate entry fee must be mailed to the Registration Chairperson. To qualify for the regular entry fee, they must be postmarked no later than **June 1, 2004** (allow 5 days for delivery). **An incomplete entry form will be considered late.** No entries will be accepted after 4 p.m. on Friday July 2, 2004.

ENTRY FEES

A non-refundable registration fee - personal check, money order or cashier's check (no cash!) will be accepted for entries postmarked on or before June 1, 2004. **All entries postmarked after June 1, 2004 will be considered late and subject to the late fee. All entries considered INCOMPLETE after June 1, 2004, will be subject to the late fee.** All late entries must include money order, cashier's check or cash (NO PERSONAL CHECKS). Money orders, cashiers check, cash or travelers checks will be accepted for late entries during registration/weigh-in on Friday July 2, 2004 (Site TBA). All funds must be in US dollars.

CHECK-IN

All national referees and officials must check-in, in person, at the Tournament Headquarters Hotel on Friday, July 2, 2004, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. **All competitors, coaches, and referees must present their actual USJF, USJA, or USJI card with proof of insurance. Those without a valid card will be required to purchase one at this time.** Competitors and Coaches who are not fully pre-registered must complete and present all required forms and pay late entry fees (see ENTRY FEES above). Registration for Coaches and Competitors will take place at site of weigh-in. Referees and Kata official are required to provide a passport-photo during registration at the referee and kata clinics.

WEIGH-INS

Contestants may check their weight, on marked practice scales, as many times as desired prior to the official weigh-ins. Contestants will be given only one chance on the scale when officially weighing in. Location of weigh-ins and registration will be posted at tournament headquarters. Weigh-ins will be conducted in conjunction with registration for **all competitors** between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Friday, July 2, 2004. **Note: There will be no Saturday weigh-ins!**

KATA CLINIC – (continued)

All Kata officials will be required to wear an Official's Badge to enter the competition arena. Officials must submit a passport-sized picture with registration form. Kata officials are required to submit a Kata Clinic, Certification and Officiating Registration form found in this registration packet.

SPECTATOR FEE (PER PERSON ADMISSION)

Admission will be \$10 for each day. All spectator ticket will be available for purchase at the Neal Blaisdell ticket office. Children under 6, competitors with proper credentials, coaches with proper credentials, referees, and USJF Life Members with proof of life member status, will be admitted free.

Individual Competition

DIVISION - AGE & WEIGHT SYSTEM

Please note that each Category is based solely on the year in which the contestant was born. The contestant's actual age on the day of competition is irrelevant. For each weight division, the weight range will be over the next lower weight and up to and including the weight listed. *Example: Bantam 1, 31 kg. - over 27 kg. And up to and including 31 kg.*

The USJF Jr. Nationals Tournament Committee (which consists of the Tournament Director, USJF President, USJF Jr. & Youth Development Subcommittee Chairperson, and the USJF Standards Committee Chairperson) reserves the right to make changes in the highest and lowest weight divisions in each category when it is in the best interest of the contestants due to weight differences. Also, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to take any weight division with two (2) or less competitors and combine it with the next highest weight division in the same age Category. Juvenile B competitors have the option to compete in the Juvenile C Category in addition to, or instead of, their own weight division. The above listed exceptions to the age/weight system may be applied only with the written consent of the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of contests under the age of 18. **See Consent for Competitive Bracket Change.**

RULES - INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

Competition will be conducted under current IJF Rules, modified for the 41st Annual USJF Junior, Youth, Team, and Kata National Championships as follows:

- Shime Waza allowed for Juvenile A, B, and C divisions only.
- Kansetsu Waza allowed for Juvenile C divisions only.
- Match length: Juvenile B and C - 5 minutes, All Others - 3 minutes.
- **Judo Gi color: The wearing of a Blue judo gi by the "blue" side competitor is optional. The "white" side competitor must wear a white judo gi. Competitors are responsible for appearing in the correct color gi. Under no circumstances shall both competitors be allowed to compete in blue Judogis, nor will the blue and white competitors be allowed to switch positions. The gi jacket and pants must be the same color; no mixing of colors. In all matches where the both competitors are wearing white Judogis, both competitors will remove their grade belts and wear a blue or white belt to identify the contestant's designated color for the match.**
- **Contestant MUST provide their own white and blue belts.**

RULES - INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION (Continued)

- **COMPETITORS AND THEIR COACHES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN BLUE AND WHITE BELT FOR THIS COMPETITION. THIS RULE WILL INSURE THAT THE BELTS FIT PROPERLY. PLEASE MARK YOUR BELTS WITH YOUR NAME OR CLUB.**
- Elimination procedures: Modified Double Elimination - PLACE 1st no losses, 2nd (1) loss, 3rd (2) losses.
- There will be no seeding of Athletes. The draw will be performed randomly with the restriction that players having the same State affiliation will be placed as far apart in the bracket as possible.
- The Texas Match Scheduling system will be used. Contestants will receive a card specifying their contest area number and match number. All contestants will report to their assigned contest area 3 matches prior to their assigned match number.
- A competitor may compete in one division only, according to their year of birth and official weight, with the following exception:
 - **For the Bantam and Intermediate Divisions Only:** If a contestant has no one else in the division he or she weighted in for, the player may move up one age or weight category where there are matches (see consent for competition bracket change form). **Any changes must be made prior to the start for the draw.**
 - Juvenile B contestant may compete in the Juvenile C Category **instead of, or in addition to**, the Juvenile B category. Those who choose to compete in both categories must fill out two entry forms and pay two entry fees.
 - The Tournament committee reserves the right to take any weight division with two (2) or less competitors and combine it with the next heavier weight division in the same age category.

Note: Please use the check-off list of items to assist in submitting all required applications, documents and fees for individual competition.

Team Competition

REGISTRATION

Only registered Yudanshakais and Associate Yudanshakais, in good standing with the United States Judo Federation, Inc., will be permitted to enter in the Yudanshakai team competition. All team competitors must be members in good standing with their respective Yudanshakai and the USJF and be registered with the national office by March 31, 2004. All team competitors must be registered only with the Yudanshakai they are representing, and not with any other Yudanshakai. All team competitors must meet all other eligibility requirements and restrictions as governed by the 41st Annual USJF Junior, Youth, Team, and Kata National Championships.

To secure a place in the team tournament, a Yudanshakai must submit the proper entry fees and a team entry form. It must be received by the Registration Chairman, and postmarked no later than **June 1, 2004 (allow 5 days for delivery)**. Any fees and applications postmarked after this date will be considered a late registration and must include the late team registration fee. **Note: the names of the team members do not need to be included on the application at this time. However, they must be supplied to the Tournament Director at least one hour prior to the start of the team competition. (An announcement will be made at the tournament).**

COMPETITION WEIGHT

The individual's official competition weight will be used as the official weight for the team competition. If a team member does not compete in the individual competition, he/she must register and weigh-in with all of the other athletes & officials on Friday, July 2, 2004. **Each team member must be properly registered for the Championships and have turned in all necessary entry forms and documentation.** A team member can only compete in one (1) team age/weight division.

AWARDING POINTS

The individual competitors shall appear in the order submitted prior to the beginning of the team competition. There will be no exceptions. If a competitor does not want to compete, or if a team does not field a member in a position, that team will forfeit that match for full ippon value. Points shall be assigned to the contestants in the following manner: win by Ippon - 5 points, Wazari - 4 points, Yuko - 3 points, Koka - 2 points, Hikiwake - 0 points. If two (2) competitors are tied at the end of the match, a decision of "Hikiwake" will be rendered. The determination of the winner will be: (a) Most wins; (b) If tied for wins, then by most points; (c) If still tied, both teams will compete again in the same order. If needed, the last match will be decided by flags. For additional clarification, please refer to the USJF Junior, Youth, and Team National Championships handbook.

RULES - TEAM COMPETITION

Current IJF Rules, modified for the 2004 USJF Team National Championships will prevail: Shime-Waza allowed for Juvenile A, B, & C divisions; Kansetsu-Waza allowed for Juvenile C brackets only. The competition rules governing the individual matches will also apply in the team competition for the corresponding age category.

Both male and female teams will compete in a modified double elimination system (winner and loser brackets). 1st Place has no losses, 2nd Place has one loss, 3rd Place has two losses. All matches will be three (3) minutes long.

TEAM COMPOSITION

Both male and female teams shall consist of five (5) members, each meeting the following age and weight criteria:

Male
One (1) competitor born 1994 - 1995 or earlier*, not more than 43 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1992 - 1993 or earlier*, not more than 53 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1990 - 1991 or earlier*, not more than 64 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1988 - 1989 or earlier*, not more than 90 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1985 - 1987 or earlier*, no weight limitation.

Female
One (1) competitor born 1994 - 1995 or earlier*, not more than 43 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1992 - 1993 or earlier*, not more than 53 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1990 - 1991 or earlier*, not more than 64 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1988 - 1989 or earlier*, not more than 79 kilograms
One (1) competitor born 1985 - 1987 or earlier*, no weight limitation

Each contestant and parent(s)/legal guardian(s), if contestant is under 18 years of age) must sign all the proper forms. No exceptions. **Note: Please use the check-off list of items to assist in submitting all required applications, documents and fees.**

**The United States Judo Federation, Inc. and the Tournament Committee do not recommend that competitors younger than the years indicated compete in an older age category. However, younger competitors (under 18 years of age) will be allowed to move up to an older age category with the prior approval of their parents(s)/legal guardian(s), coach/instructor, and upon completion of all forms.*

Kata Competition

The Kata competition has been expanded to include Nage No Kata, Katame No Kata and Ju No Kata

ELIGIBILITY

All junior registered USJF, USJI, USJA and International Players in good standing are eligible to compete in the Kata portion of this National Championship. All team members must meet all other eligibility requirements and restrictions as governed by the 41st Annual USJF Junior, Youth, Team, and Kata National Championships.

There will be two divisions for Nage-No Kata:

Junior Division:

Judoka born 1992 to 1996, inclusive. Male, Female, or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: First three sets of Nage-No-Kata. (Te, Koshi, and Ashi-waza)

Youth Division:

Judoka born 1985 to 1991 inclusive. Male, Female, or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: Full set of Nage-No-Kata

There will be two divisions for Katame-No Kata:

Junior Division:

Judoka born 1992 to 1996, inclusive. Male, Female, or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: First two sets of Katame-No-Kata. (Katame-waza, Shime-waza)

Youth Division:

Judoka born 1985 to 1991 inclusive. Male, Female or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: Full set of Katame-No-Kata

There will be two divisions for Ju-No Kata:

Junior Division:

Judoka born 1992 to 1996, inclusive. Male, Female, or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: First two sets of Ju-No-Kata. (Ikkyo, Nikyo)

Youth Division:

Judoka born 1985 to 1991 inclusive. Male, Female, or mixed teams allowed.
Requirements: Full set of Ju-No-Kata

KATA COMPETITION TIME

Competition will take place on Saturday, July 3, 2004, FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF THE SHIAI COMPETITION.

KATA ENTRY INFORMATION

Teams must submit the proper entry fees and application for EACH Kata category and it must be postmarked no later than **June 1, 2004 (allow 5 days for delivery)**. Any applications postmarked after this date will be considered a late registration and must include the late team registration fee. **The actual names of the team members must be stated on the application form and sent in as one application.** Kata applications sent in separately will be returned as incomplete. Fees for the Kata competition are the same as for individual competition and will be assessed at \$100 per team, per Kata. Each team member must have all properly completed Waiver forms, Consents and Liability Releases, Proof of Age Requirements, and all other forms required for this competition. **Note: Please use the check-off list of items to assist in submitting all required applications, documents and fees for individual competition.**

Information for All Competitors

SPECIAL NOTES

1. Competitors do not have to pre-qualify to enter this competition.
2. All competitors are expected to behave appropriately. Any misconduct at the tournament site, tournament headquarters or elsewhere in connection with this competition will be grounds for automatic disqualification from this tournament. All contestants, their parents, coaches and instructors will be held personally responsible for any personal or property damage incurred due to misconduct.
3. The USJF Tournament Committee, which will include the USJF President and the Chairs of the Standards Committee and Junior Development Subcommittee, has the right to make any changes necessary for the betterment of the tournament.

AWARDS

Awards will be given for First, Second and Third in the Individual, Team and Kata competition. Special Awards will also be presented. All award recipients must be wearing a Judo-gi.

1. **Incomplete Registrations:** If any part of this registration packet is incomplete and requires further processing, a \$5 processing fee will be assessed each time an application is returned to you. **If an application is submitted on time but is incomplete and returned after the June 1, 2004 deadline, it will be considered a late application and appropriate late fees will be assessed.**
2. **Mailing Instructions:** Mailed registrations should arrive by June 8th at the latest. If you plan to send applications within 5 days of check in, you should consider hand carrying them to the tournament registration. If desired, send the CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION AND SELF ADDRESSED STAMP ENVELOPE.

4. **Check List:** This entire registration packet should be returned to the Registration Chairman, appropriately completed and with the correct entry fee(s) and additional documents enclosed. Please use the check-off list (below) to ensure you have completed the registration packet in its entirety.
5. **Entries:** Each entry requires a separate Official Entry Form. If entering more than one competition, such as individual and Kata, or a Juvenile B also entering Juvenile C division, additional Official Entry Forms must be completed and included. You may photocopy additional Official Entry Forms. All waivers should be read very carefully and understood by each competitor, parent(s), legal guardian(s), judo instructor(s) and coach(es) before completing and signing them. **The waivers are to be completed and signed by all contestants (where indicate) regardless of age,** and signed by parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of contestants under 18 years of age.
6. The tournament Committee reserves the right to make any changes when it is in the best interest of the contestants or these Championships, or to reject any forms that contain false data or are not properly and fully completed.
7. Include two (2) passport sized photos with the contestant's name, Judo club, date of birth, and listed on the back of each photo.
