

# 2009 50<sup>th</sup> State Judo Association Scholarship Program

The 50<sup>th</sup> State Judo Association is pleased to again provide a program geared to provide financial assistance to select members. The Scholarship program was developed to help offset educational expenses for our member pursuing post high school education. A candidate may receive only one scholarship or award a year, but may apply for all eligible programs. Each candidate will be required to reapply annually for each year of eligibility.

Eligible candidates must complete and submit their entry form, post marked no later than March 31, 2010. Scholarship award winners will be notified before April 30, 2010. Applications can be mailed to:

Each Judoka will be required to fulfill the following:

- Must be a member in good standing with the 50<sup>th</sup> State Judo Association for at least two years.
- Copies of recent report cards.
- A letter of recommendation from a Judo instructor, teacher, counselor, school official, church official, coach or other adult authority.
- Proof of participation in Judo class, tournament and/or other judo related event.
- List of recent Judo accomplishments including standing in local, regional, national and international competition between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009.
- Completed 50<sup>th</sup> State Judo Association Scholarship form.

School activities/awards, extra-curricular activities, Judo awards and letters of recommendation or commendation may also be included.

## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

This scholarship program has been developed to provide financial assistance to members of the 50<sup>th</sup> State Judo Association who wish to pursue post high school educational opportunities. Through this scholarship program, scholarship awards will help to fund the scholarship recipient's educational expenses associated with post high school education from an accredited nationally recognized institution. Candidates applying for the scholarship program must be enrolled by the end of 2010.

For the 2009 Scholarship Program, a total of three scholarship categories have been identified. In each category, a five hundred dollar award will be made available to an eligible male and female member. The scholarship award recipient will be required to use these funds for educational expenses as set forth above.

Scholar Athlete Scholarship - \$500  
Competitor Scholarship - \$500  
Referee Scholarship - \$500
